Dear Family,

Your child has just completed the third lesson of **play safe! be safe!**, BIC Corporation's fire safety education program for young children.

In this important lesson, your child learned that if he or she is ever in a room with smoke, the correct action is to **get low under the smoke** until reaching the outside and fresh air.

Praise your child for learning this safety technique and for earning the **get low and go!** certificate. Please help your child be safe. Practice **getting low under smoke** with your child and show your child **how to exit** your home in case of fire.

How to get low and go:

The correct way for a young child to escape from a room with smoke is to crawl on hands and knees—with head up about 18" from the floor—and go quickly to the outside and the fresh air. Always remind your child that **get low and go** is only to be used when they are in a **room with smoke**.

Your child was also taught to know two ways out of every room in order to find the quickest exit away from the fire and smoke. Your child is bringing home cut-outs of pointing hands to use to identify two ways out of each room in your own home. Take your child from room to room and have your child attach the hands to the wall to show you two ways out.



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
